Paying for School Lunches and Breakfast Club

There has been an increase in the number of families who are not paying for their child's lunches or for their child's place at breakfast club. Please remember to keep your Parent Pay account up to date so that debt does not build up. P1-5 children are entitled to free school lunches, but not breakfast club unless you have applied for and been successful for free school meals. I have included below how to do this.

How to Apply for Free School Meal and Clothing Grant



Do you qualify for this? Forms are available on the Glasgow website www.glasgow.gov.uk if eligible. The forms should be returned to Glasgow City Council, Grants Section, PO Box 26816, Glasgow G2 9AF. Forms can also be handed in to the Service Desk at 45 John Street, however no forms should be posted to John Street.

Please do not hesitate to contact the school if you want to speak to someone about a concern or suggestion as together we'll succeed.

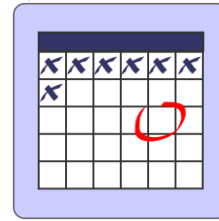
